It's been 20 years since WTSG was formed, to take over the maintenance of 150km of walking trail established by Royal Geographical Society members and hand-picked members of Friends of Heysen Trail. The volunteers remained the same, but continued as a determined group under Friends of Parks Inc.

Membership has expanded, and the interest continues. We have achieved improvements to trail routes, replaced outdated hardware, developed a system of providing interpretive leaflets at trailheads and the government now undertakes to print them.
